



Export Tracker synopsis

Created by Jack Altieri and Karen Lutz
Based upon an idea from the IABL.

This program will allow for online leagues to monitor the last export made by a team instantly.

Instructions

Place the page on your server in any place you wish, in the same area of your server create 2 folders, 1 named 'league' and one named 'Old Exports' both without the ". All of your exports should be sent to the 'league' folder, you may need to change this in your game.

All exports that are located in the 'league' folder will display a black date on the page. If you wish, you may move your exports after each sim, or at your leisure, to the 'Old Exports' folder. Any exports moved to the 'Old Exports' folder will display a red date. If you delete your exports, the page will show no updated record.

This export tracker will display a regular 30 team setup. If you wish to remove teams you may do so by doing the following:
Start by deleting the php code stamps from the end until you are left with same amount of php stamps as teams in your league. Rename the teams in the text columns to the teams you wish. The php stamps are all set to individual teams, ORIOLES being team 1, REDSOX being team 2 etc. Just like the normal league structure in OOTP. Should you wish to make each php area easier, simply replace the team names with numbers, example:

BEFORE:

FAQ's

- Q- My page shows an error that one of the files is not found.
A- You have moved/deleted either the 'league' folder or the 'Old Exports' folder. Both of these folders need to be in the same directory on your server as the page itself.
- Q- One or many of my teams do not show up when they export.
A- You may have some of the php code out of order, try removing the team name in the php field and replacing it with the teams ID number. There is an example above.
- Q- This page is too confusing, can I get some help?
A- Contact info is below, I will talk to you on AIM if you require help.
- Q- The page doesn't display properly, there is a big mess.
A- Check and be sure your server supports php code, if it does not, this page will appear as a big mess and will not work. If your server does support php and it appears messed up, feel free to use the contact info below to get help.

Known Issues

1. If your 'league' folder and your 'Old Exports' folder are not on the same level on your server, the page will show errors.
2. Some servers do not support .php files, this page will not work for such servers.
